A DAY AT FALLS CREEK

Here is a brief explanation of what takes place at Falls Creek on a daily basis:

QUIET TIME: 8:40am

This in-cabin time is designed for students to be alone with God. A short Quiet Time guide based on the theme of the day will be provided for students in the student book.

IN-CABIN BIBLE STUDY 9:00am

In-Cabin Bible study and challenge is a cornerstone of Falls Creek. We will meet in our cabin for an in-depth study of our camp theme. Our FBC Mustang Pastors come down and teach the Bible Study each day and spend time with the group.

MORNING WORSHIP SERVICES 10:30am

Middle School and High School students will meet together in the tabernacle to worship beginning at 9:45am. This time includes worship through song, the camp video series, and theme-based teaching.

RECREATION 1:30-5:30pm

Falls Creek provides more recreational options than any person or group could possibly do in a week. Tournament recreation is held at Riverfront Recreation Field with the exception of Ping-Pong, which will be held at the pavilion adjacent to SwiftSkate Park. A variety of other individual and group recreation options are available throughout the afternoon. Breakouts are also available throughout free- time.

EVENING WORSHIP SERVICE 7:30-9:00pm

The Evening Worship Service is the culmination service each evening. This service has worship and preaching each night.

EVENING CABIN DEVOTIONAL 10:15pm

Our evening In-Cabin time is a favorite at Falls Creek. We have theme nights that students dress up for and compete in games and activities each evening. We also have a guest worship leader lead us in song and wrap up the day with a devotion and small group time led by our sponsors.

Dress Code

While we understand the desire for fashionable attire, we require you to wear modest clothing. Modesty is a biblical principle and helps keep people focused on the important things at camp. (1

Timothy 2:9-10; 4:12)

General Guidelines:

- Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your dorm.
- Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.
- Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. No boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- No tank tops.
- No short shorts. At a minimum, shorts must extend to, or just beyond, the campers' fingertips or be 5-7" inseam.
- No tight-fitting and revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.
- Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee.

Swimming:

- Girls should wear modest one-piece swimsuits. Guys should not wear tight-fitting swimming suits.
- » While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimming suits.

Code of Conduct

All campers are expected to follow Falls Creek and FBC Mustang's Code of Conduct. All rules and sponsor instructions should be followed at all times.

The **dress code** must be followed, but we acknowledge that modesty extends beyond the dress code. As such, students should refrain from PDA (Public Displays of Affection).

Cell phones will be allowed at camp but will be taken up daily and will be restricted to afternoon free time only. Use of cell phones during any other time will be grounds for loss of the phone for the remainder of the week.

Students may receive consequences for rule-breaking or be dismissed from camp and a parent/guardian will be required to pick up and take the student home.

Zero Tolerance

Hazing, pranks, sexual harassment, and abusive speech or actions toward others are strictly prohibited.

Any student in possession of a zero-tolerance item will be immediately dismissed from camp and a parent/guardian will be required to pick up and take the student home.
